Demonstrated significant involvement in the Warrnambool community.	Demonstrated leadership/participation in the Warrnambool community that has had short/long term benefits to others.	Given outstanding service to the local community, in a predominantly unpaid capacity over a number of years including the contribution towards improving the quality of life of others.

Warrnambool Community Event of the Year Award	Event must be held within the Warrnambool community.		Organisations/groups must reside within the Warrnambool City municipality.		Conducted a successful project, event or activity bringing benefit to the community; <i>and/or</i> Raised funds for a community charity/event/project.

Warrnambool Local Achiever Award	Nominees must be Australian citizens.	Made a significant volunteer contribution to a specific Warrnambool area or activity.	Commitment to activities that has had short/long term benefits to others	Demonstrated significant involvement in the Warrnambool community.	Demonstrated leadership/participation in the Warrnambool community, in a predominantly unpaid capacity that has had short/long term benefits to others.

Notes: Contribution could include areas such as education, health, fund-raising, voluntary services, sports, arts or the environment or any other area that contributions to the advancement and wellbeing of the community.
